

Membership Categories and Fees

Full Member (Single membership)

This category is open to anyone paying the full membership fee. This entitles the Member to all the benefits and privileges of the British Beekeepers Association including their insurance scheme for up to 3 hives. For more than 3 hives there is an additional insurance premium – see later. The member will receive a copy of the BBKA Journal every month.

Friend of Whitehaven and District Beekeepers

This category is open to those paying the Friend of W&DBK fee. This entitles the friend to all the Branch newsletters, apiary visits and social events. It does not entitle them to membership of the British Beekeeping Association, nor insurance cover.

Family Membership

This category is open to families (Two adults and all children in the family under the age of 18). It entitles the Family to BBKA membership for one adult with all the insurance cover, and the whole family to the activities and publications of the Branch.
